**\$241,663\***

## This funding will be used to

- Increase % of students achieving A and B in English from 53.3% to 56%.
- Maintain 62.2% or above in Upper two bands for reading year 3 and 5
- Achieve 35% or more in Upper two bands for writing in year 5 and 60% or above in year 3.
- School based reading and writing assessment showing 1 year or more improvement for every student.
- Whole school writing and reading programs implemented in all classrooms.
- Reading and writing goals explicit for all students.

## Our initiatives include

- Collaboratively develop and implement whole school writing program
- Review whole school reading program
- Students use a common school based editing checklist
- Reading and writing goals and success criteria are explicit, visible and updated in all classrooms
- Professional development for teachers and teacher aides in reading and writing aligning with Australian Curriculum
- Use all PRSS Key Pedagogical Practices to teach writing and reading
- Continue collaborative planning with year level teams to enable consistency of programming
- Continue to build leaders and teachers data literacy to inform teaching
- Continue and expand upon the implementation of Age Appropriate Pedagogies
- Allocate teacher aides to specific year levels to support in literacy groups
- Purchase additional resources and provide professional development to maximise their implementation in the teaching of reading and writing

• Releasing teachers for planning	\$61,000
• Increasing teacher aide hours to provide more opportunities for differentiation in classrooms	\$77,000
• Purchasing additional Literacy and numeracy resources	\$42,000
• Additional digital resources	\$18,663
• Gifted and Talented programs	\$4,000
